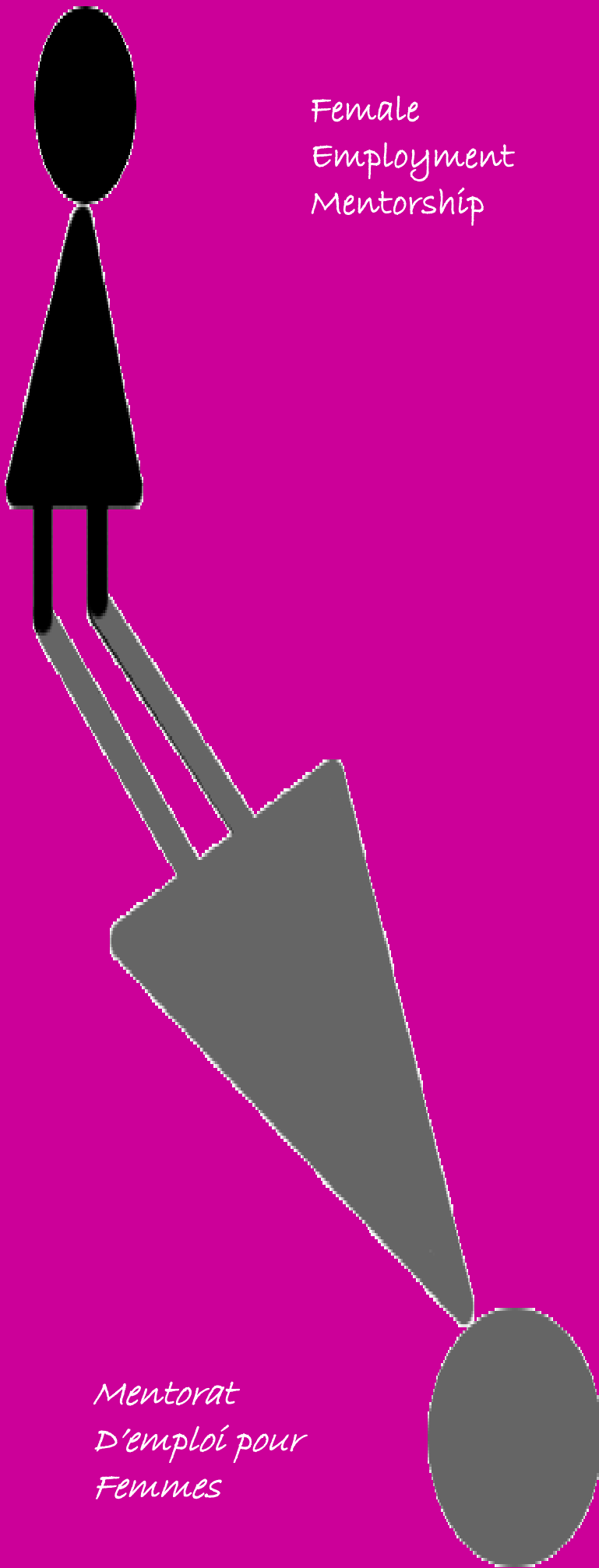

Placement Opportunities for Young Women between the age of 18 and 30

T.A.P.P. is now accepting resumes from women for the Female Employment Mentorship (FEM) programs **starting in October 2010**, which is funded through the Government of Canada's Skills Link Program.

Under the Skills Link program, women who meet the required standards will work on a paid 18 weeks work placement in the private or public field under the mentorship of the Female Employment Mentorship (FEM) program.

In addition to this, the women will learn skills in technology, office management, publicity and focus groups, writing, delivering presentations, project planning, organizing meetings and many other areas during a 6-week paid placement preparation period. They will be challenged personally to focus on their lives, and to set and achieve personal and career goals for themselves during workshops at the T.A.P.P. facilities.

Program Requirements:

- Between the ages of 18 and 30 (inclusive) at the time of intake selection;
- In need of assistance to overcome employment barriers;
- Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or persons with refugee status;
- Out of school;
- Legally entitled to work according to relevant provincial legislation and regulations;
- Not in receipt of Employment Insurance (EI) benefits.

- Be ready to work hard
- Be ready to be on time
- Be ready and willing to challenge yourself
